- 1. **Minutes:** Review and Approval of Minutes from 11DEC2013 Meeting: Approved
- 2. **Discussion**: Presentation by Carlos Carrasco:
 - 1. CG as living room of university:
 - a. 303,000 sq. ft. facility
 - b. Retail Operations: Barnes & Noble, Food Services, Hair Salon, Barber Shop, Panther's Cleaners and the new Panther Tech Store
 - c. 23 classrooms
 - d. Student support services offices
 - Event Venues: Ballrooms, Panther Suite, Meeting Rooms, GC 140 and GC 150 auditoriums
 - f. Computer Lab with 77 PCs
 - g. 15,342 events in 2013
 - h. Over 4.0 million guests per year
 - 2. Recycling measures at GC:
 - a. 10 duplex bins added in last 6 mo.
 - b. Dyson dryers: slight drop in paper towel use (10%); no heating element, therefore energy savings
 - c. LED vs. tungsten lights in fish tank (energy savings)
 - 3. Diesel Tanks for generators: EPA mandated these be above ground
 - a. Mahadev: safety issues of having exposed fuel
 - 4. Acoustic & Lighting challenges of GC: loud and off-putting acoustically
 - a. CC: light and sound improvement proposal by MC Harry is underway
 - i. Drawings expected by end of month
 - 5. Atrium area: has no recycling options/bins despite heavy use of the area (Subway, SushiMaki)
 - 6. Student Government funds 2/3 of operations from fees
 - 7. Business Services funds for common areas; furnishings
 - a. Tony Vu: can Business Services also fund recycling efforts (vs. using E&G and A&S funding)?
 - 8. Styrofoam still being used:
 - a. Business Services is working with vendors to change this
 - b. Constance: some Styrofoam is better/more environmentally friendly than others
 - i. Recommendation:
 - make sure that the type being used by GC abides by these standards
 - 2. omit Styrofoam altogether
 - c. Business Service contacts: Jeff Krablin, Roger Clegg (Aramark)
 - 9. Tony Vu: perhaps we can bring together Aramark/GC/ Facilities/Business Services to discuss how to track and have a standard for recycling on campus
 - 10. Peter Craumer: not a lot of issues concerning recycling in BBC; only 10% is contaminated in university as a whole; mostly about curbing careless behavior
 - 11. Carlos: vendors are agreeable to best practices and making changes
